- Are you interested in becoming a Teacher or Health Worker?
- Do you need to upgrade your school education to grade 10, grade 11 and grade 12?
- Are you able to study at home?

If you have answered YES to all of the above questions and live in a village in Central or Oro Province and can access Kokoda then you may be eligible to complete FODE at the Kokoda College. Listed on the reverse of this Tok Save are the key academic dates where you will be required to attend classes at the Kokoda College in Kou Kou Village. You must be willing to commit to further study from home outside of the dates listed.

## REGISTRATION WEEK: MON 10 TO FRI 14 FEBRUARY 2020

### REQUIREMENTS & REGISTRATION

You will be required to attend the Kokoda College during REGISTRATION WEEK. During the registration week, you will be interviewed by a selection committee to see if you are eligible to commence study. You must be able to commit to funding your own travel to and from Kokoda 4 times each year.

Please ensure you bring the following items with you to registration:

- A written letter of interest in the program
- All academic transcripts received to date
- Your 300 Kina course fee deposit to cover the loan of all materials

### COURSE FEES & RULES

If you are a successful candidate to enter into the Kokoda College FODE program, all fees will be covered by KTF free of charge\*. This includes enrolment fees, course materials and assessments and all boarding related expenses during your lodging times.

\*A 300 Kina deposit will be charged to successful candidates as insurance of course completion & the safe return of equipment. This will be returned upon completion of study.

You must be willing and able to participate in all components of the program at the college and at home.

You must be willing and able to fund your own travel to and from the college 4 times each year.
